



**Learning Assessment
 Tiered Fee Scale
 Effective July 1, 2009**

In order to make learning assessments as accessible as possible, CSS offers a tiered fee scale. The fee scale is available to any family living in New Hampshire or Vermont. Learning assessment costs are determined by a family's *Adjusted Gross Income*. This figure can be found on **line 37** of your 2009 1040 tax return.

On the chart below you will notice four columns. The first column lists the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) category. The second column provides the AGI range for each category. The third column lists the learning assessment cost for each category. For example, if your family's AGI is \$68,000 you would fall into Category C (\$59,001-\$70,000) and the cost of a learning assessment would be \$2000. All groups (except Group E) will be required to submit the most recent 1040 tax return for AGI verification upon request.

Some insurance companies **may** reimburse portions of the assessment, depending on your policy and deductible. CSS can supply a sample invoice with information you can provide to your insurance company for pre-approval process. **It is also helpful to ask your child's health care provider to make a specific referral to your insurance company for a CSS assessment.**
